DIRECTOR OF RESIDENTIAL CARE

Hello everyone!

Here we find ourselves already in November with many activities on the card. We will commemorate Remembrance Day with a small inhouse service and utilise our war memorial which is now replaced on the front landing. Melbourne Cup Dy will again bring some excitement as the Lifestyle team and Kitchen are busy planning for an exciting day. A fashion on the fields event and sweeps will all be on the cards in the residential facility.

We have a very busy few months with the UNISA students in the home providing

additional services to our Care Recipients and conducting research to develop new

resources for us to use. We have had projects done around work health and safety and falls prevention with OT and Physio students and now how firm programs in place and

improvements made because of the wonderful student input. The 6 UNISA Nursing

students worked along side our experienced nurses and care staff and will finish up at the end of this week.We have also had some local TAFE students completing their

placements. All the exposure of our facility with the students in place will hopefully boost the Aged Care workforce as the students learn and appreciate the environment we

provide to our vulnerable community.



DIRECTOR OF RESIDENTIAL CARE

We have had information from the Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunization (ATAGI) about the Shingles Vaccine. It is suggested that adults over 65 should speak with their GP about their health risks and consideration for the Shingles vaccine. I will write to each clinic and ask that the GPs discuss the vaccine with their patients at MFH and consider administering the vaccine if required. I will also be doing an audit on the vaccination status of our Care Recipients and arranging a vaccination clinic at MFH to offer any CR who may have missed the last COVID vaccine or any other vaccines available to them.

We continue to remind our Visitors and Staff that community infections are still around potentially putting our vulnerable at risk. We ask that you stay away if unwell and consider a phone call to your loved one if you are unable to visit. We also ask that visitors are vigilant when entering and exiting and check with staff before letting anyone out of the doors who may have their safety put at risk if left alone outside.

Please remember to continue giving us feedback. We use all feedback to make improvement to our services. We have an open-door policy and encourage you to provide verbal or written feedback at any time. Small problems are easy to manage but big problems can be more difficult, so we ask that you raise them early and allow us to fix them.

We kicked off the first week with a High Tea and an array of indoor activities that saw some records broken on our 'Day Centre Guiness Records' board!





Mangers or Home Support Workers know when they attend your home.


